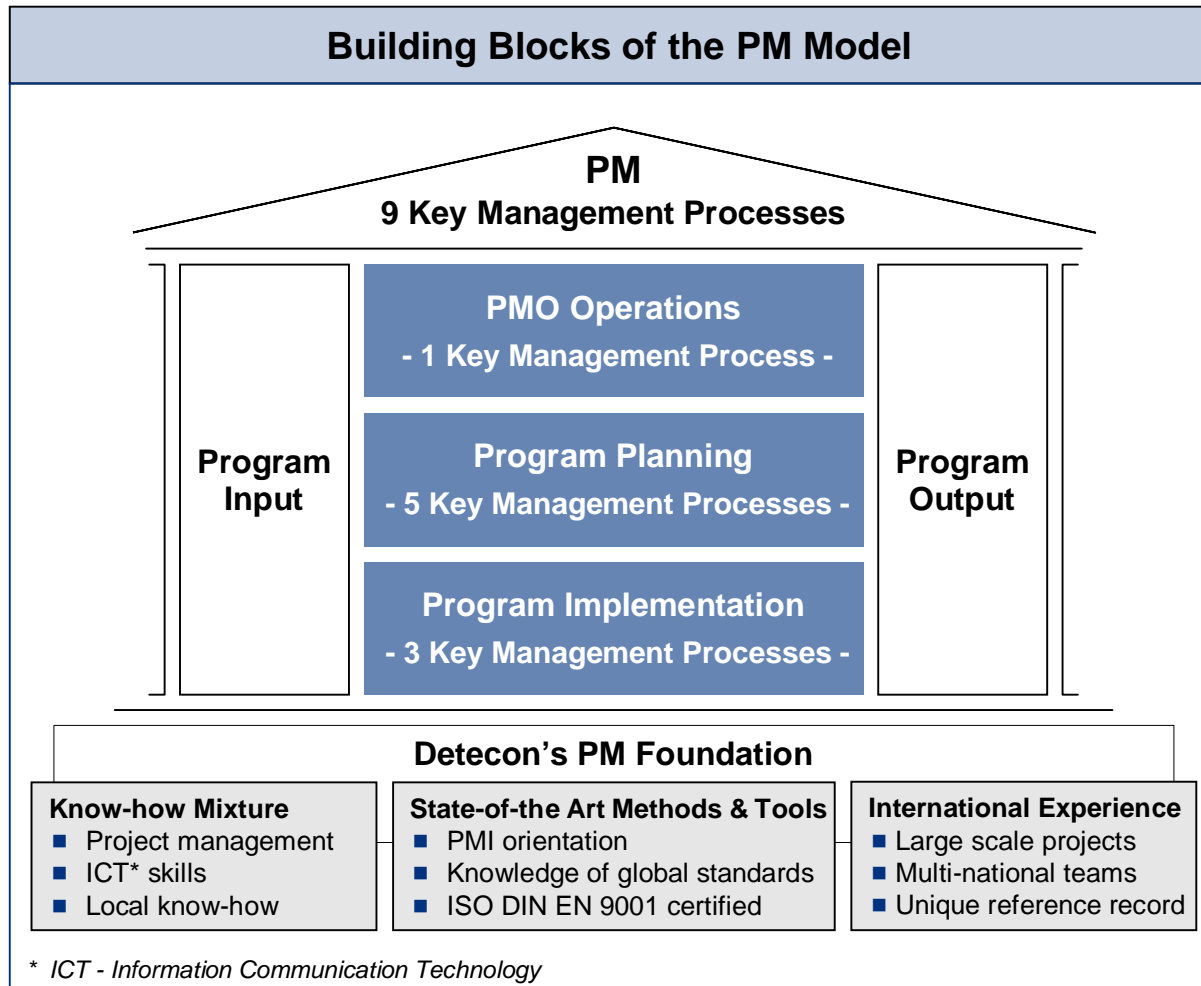

Managing a program in its constraints 'time - budget - quality' is crucial for every network operator. To meet this objective Detecon has developed a powerful PM model.

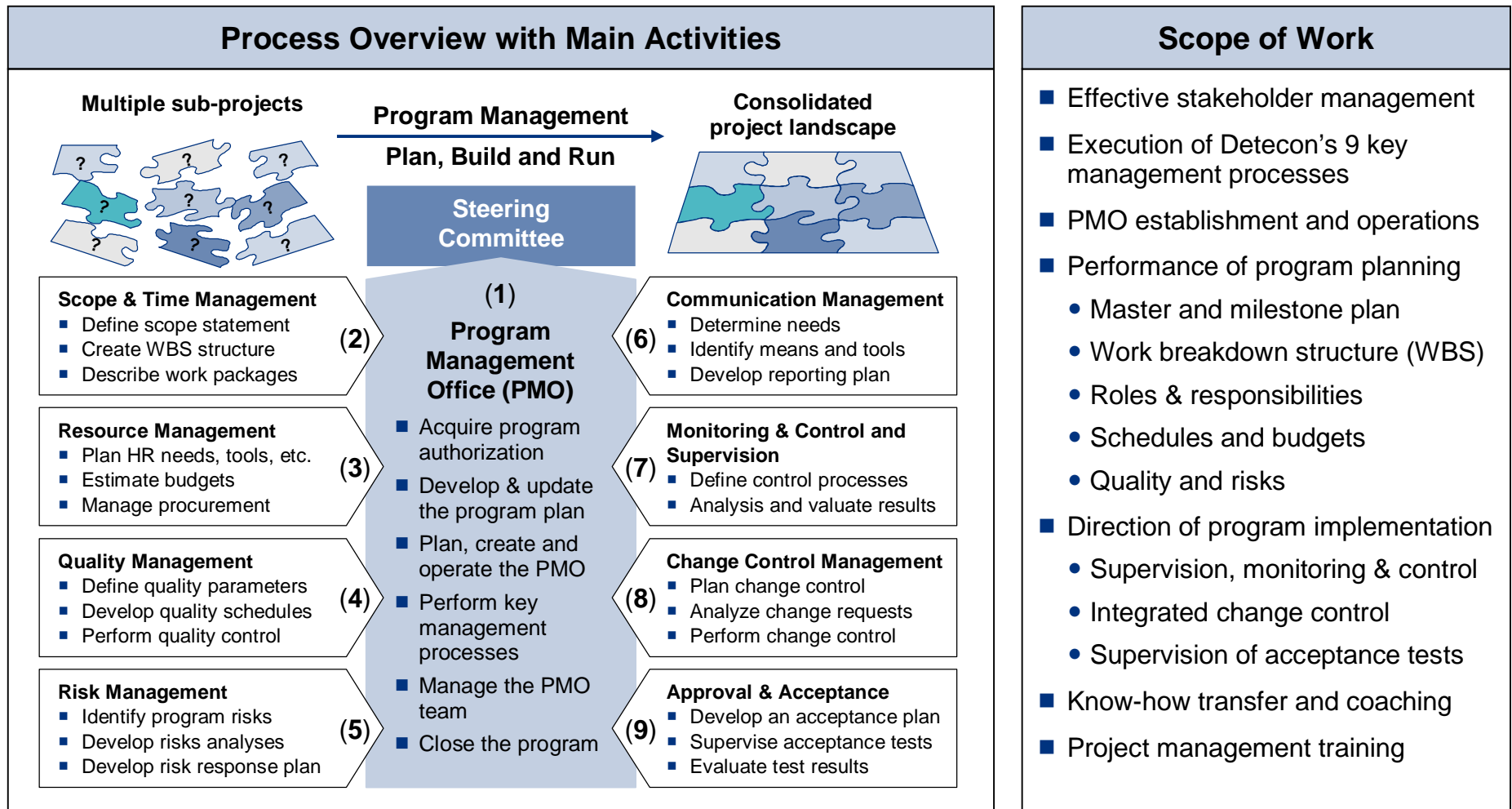
